Goodwill of Southern Nevada is proud to partner with our local letter carriers, United Way, Three Square food bank and other local organizations for this year's **National Association of Letter Carriers' "Stamp out Hunger Food Drive."**

The "Stamp out Hunger Food Drive" is the largest one day food drive in the country. Last year, about 73 tons of food was collected nationally.

Traditionally, letter carriers distribute post cards asking residents to leave a bag of non-perishable groceries at their door. Letter carriers pick up the donated food as they are delivering and dropping off the mail. However, due to the increased number of neighborhood box units, donations have been down in recent years.

By providing **27 Goodwill sites for the community to drop food**, Goodwill hopes to increase food donations in Las Vegas. **This year's goal is to raise 500,000 pounds of food for local food banks.**

### **HOW TO DONATE ON SATURDAY, MAY 9th:**

- **Drop non-perishable food items at ANY Goodwill donation location between 9am and 6pm**
- **Donate at Albertsons stores where Goodwill has donation centers between 8am and 1pm**
- **Leave non-perishable items at your door for your letter carrier**
