Goodwill has held “Mobile” Stores at UNLV, multiple CSN campuses, and Caesars Entertainment properties. The idea of focusing the “Mobile” Stores on career wear was generated from the first store at UNLV, an idea other area colleges have latched on to, but other “Mobile” stores have focused on Back-to-School and Holiday items.

The profits from all items sold at “Mobile” Stores fund Goodwill’s job placement and job training programs. Goodwill looks forward to additional “Mobile” Stores as 2011 progresses.
